

# EVOA Appearance / Attire Standards – BASE

## Grooming:

1. Clean shaven – no day old growth
2. Mustache – neatly trimmed
3. Beard – neatly trimmed
4. Hair – neatly trimmed

## Uniform:

1. Jackets: Boathouse Jacket with Blue/White/Red trim on wrists and waist.
2. Shirts – short and long sleeve\*\*
  - a. Navy with navy, red and white trim on sleeve and collar. No dazzle finish shirts
  - b. EVOA patch/embroidery on pocket.
  - c. Numbers (if assigned): 4” red over white on right sleeve
  - d. **T-shirts worn under base shirt - RED**
3. Slacks: Charcoal Gray Base or Combo Slacks. NO CUFFS (Starting spring 2012, charcoal gray slacks are the standard Association color. Heather Gray will be grandfathered until January 1, 2015.)
4. Belt: Black; minimum width 1.50” (Davis models BL25FL and BL73GL as examples)
5. Base Shoes: POLISHED BLACK (white trim acceptable)
6. Socks: Navy or Black
7. Cap: New Era or Richardson; Navy; 4, 6, or 8 row stitching; fitted NO MESH HATS!
  - a. Any other head/face gear worn must be approved by the Baseball Committee.
8. Gloves: Black (Davis model AC6751 or AC 6753 as examples)
9. Cell phones and pagers shall not be taken on to fields without prior approval of commissioner. An exception is granted to military, medical, police, fire, and emergency services personnel who are on call.

\*\*Light Blue Shirt may be worn for summer schedule if partner also has matching shirt. (Davis model SH2115-34 and the like.) The T-shirt worn under is navy blue or white.

Numbers (if assigned): 4” navy over white on right sleeve.
