## Pre-game

- Conducted at least 30 minutes prior to game
- Discuss areas of responsibility
- Work as a unit
- Expectations of the game

## Helpful tips

### Establish pre-pitch routine

- Anticipate next play (Movement)
- Identify jersey color for obstruction/interference
- Responsibility for tag ups
- Illegal pitch
- Runners on base

### Big 6 (85% of the game)

- Balls/strikes
- Fair/foul
- Safe/out
- All impact the flow of the game

## Communication

- Important aspect to a successful game
- Verbal with your partner
  - On tag ups
  - · Catch/no catch
- Non-verbal
  - Eye contact
  - Signals

\*\*\* If you deviate from normal movement you MUST communicate (ie Base umpire goes out)

## 4 Elements

- Runners
- Defensive player
- Base
- Softball

Watch your partner when ball is hit to outfield to observe what the rotation will be on the base

# Plate Umpire positioning

- Explain the "slot"
- On a fly ball in outfield
- Infield ball
- · Dropped third strike



# Base umpire position

- Explain A,B,C slot
- · No runners on base
- Runner on first
- · Runners on first and second
- Bases loaded
- Steals

# Umpire Responsibility-Plate

### Plate umpire

- Pre-game with partner
- Plate conference
- Line-ups and substitutions
- Balls and strikes
- Fair or fair ball
- Safe and outs
- Catch or no catch on fly balls
- Signal infield fly when appropriate
- Illegal pitches
- Handle appeals by coaches

## Umpire Responsibility-Base

### **Base umpire**

- · Safe and outs
- Illegal pitches
- Check swings (assist home plate umpire)
- Obstruction/interference
- Infield fly
- Ensure all bases are touched
- Tag ups

# Umpire movement

### Plate umpire

- · Trail batted runner
- Location on catch/no catch
- · No runners on vs runners on base

### Base Umpire

- Inside/out –Button hook
- · Coverage on steals
- First call
- Relinquish runner to plate umpire
- · Angles are your friend

# **Umpire Rotation**

- All scenarios can be found in the Umpires Manual
- Not all will be covered in class
- Several on field opportunities available

## Mechanics

#### **Plate**

Position in "slot"

Timing on strike call

Good strike call

Dead ball

Loud calls

Punch out strike outs

#### **Base**

Make call standing still


Solid out call (Hammer fist)

Smooth safe call (no swimming)


Point to the ground (Dropped third strike)


Point to the sky (Infield fly)



#### BASE HIT TO THE OUTFIELD




### FLY BALL TO THE OUTFIELD, BALL IS CAUGHT, B DOES NOT CHASE




